## Why a Capital Fund Campaign?

The Sarah Hull Hallock Free Library (SHHFL) has launched a \$60,000 capital fundraising campaign in order to reconfigure the children's area in the Annex and refresh the 1924 historic section of the library.

SHHFL was grateful to receive a capital grant award from NY State to help consolidate the children's collection and build a new accessible circulation desk in the Annex. This grant covers work in the Annex only.

The Capital Fund Campaign extends improvements beyond the Annex to enhance the 1924 section of the library building, and its lovely details from the last century: dark woodwork, coffered ceiling, fireplace, to name a few. Plans include new carpeting, painting, energy-efficient lighting, and shelving.
